INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Please read carefully before use

When you receive your kit allow the contents of the jar to settle as things may move in transit.

Before you start we recommend a test patch is carried out using a small amount of the product, following all the directions.

The area to be treated must be clean, dry, and free of cosmetics.

Your kit contains:

Sugar paste

Spatulas

Barrier powder

Strips

You will also need...

A kettle

A pudding bowl or similar DO NOT USE A DEEP BOWL and never a CUP

A clean tea towel or cloth for removing the glass jar from the hot water

Cotton wool pads for aftercare use

Preparation preparation preparation

Kit Preparation -

Open the box and lay out all the contents on a clean space or even a small plate.

Boil your kettle of water - this is to heat the product.

Important - DO NOT MICROWAVE

VERY IMPORTANT NOTE: Do not use a microwave as sugar can reach extremely high temperatures

Skin preparation -

We want you to get the best results so please prepare the area to be treated by making sure the skin is clean, dry, and free of any cosmetics (you can do this whilst the sugar is being heated, more detailed instructions are below in the 'preparing the area i.e. your face' paragraph)

Let's get started...

- Take the jar of sugar and loosen the lid very slightly - this will make it easier to open later.
- Place the jar of sugar paste in the clean empty bowl not a deep bowl (as stated above)
- Pour the hot water into the pudding bowl, so it goes halfway up the sugar paste jar.
- Leave in the bowl for at least 3 mins

NOTE:

DO NOT submerge.

The water must not come more than halfway up the jar, it is essential that the sugar does not come into contact with the water as it will become ineffective.

Preparing the area i.e. your face...

So whilst the product is heating up to a consistency that can be applied, you can start preparing your skin;

- clean the area of skin to be treated with your usual toner or just warm water on a cotton wool pad
- pat the skin dry with a clean cloth or towel or cotton wool pad
- dip your clean and dry finger in the barrier powder and dab a small amount on the area to be treated.

Here we go!

- After the time has elapsed, remove the sugar paste jar from the water with a cloth, being careful not to burn yourself with the water. Dry off sides of the sugar paste jar - DO NOT GET ANY WATER IN THE PRODUCT
- Check the product is warm enough - You can do this by placing the wooden spatula provided in the pot at the edges where it will be softer.

NOTE: Store at room temperature.

If the sugar is too stiff i.e., you feel the stick may break or does break, simply place the sugar paste jar back in water for a further minute. (if you run out of spatulas you can use a clean handle of a metal teaspoon). Different room temperatures will also determine the amount of time you may need to soften the paste, the colder the room the longer you will need.

Nearly there...

DO ONE SIDE at a time (top lip)

- Take a small amount of product on the spatula and with the other hand pull the skin taut, pull near the corner of your mouth downwards.
- At the same time press your tongue under the lip to help make the skin taut
- With your wooden spatula spread the product thinly in the direction of hair growth on the area to be depilated
- Take the small white strip
- Making sure you leave approx. 1 cm at the end of the strip as this will be the part you hold on to and...
- Place it on top of the product smoothing down with your finger in the direction of the hair growth
- Make sure you press firmly to allow the product to grip the hair

The moment of truth...

- Pull the skin taut again - remember to press your tongue under your lip to help make the skin taut.
- Hold on to the end of the strip and pull against the direction of hair growth.

NOTE:

Pull as close to the skin as possible, do not pull away from the face - imagine a plane taking off NOT a helicopter.

If you tap and press the skin of the area you have just removed the hair from it will take out the sting if any occurs.

Et Voila! Beautifully smooth skin

After removing the strip take some cold water on a cotton pad and pat and wipe gently, removing any sugar that may be left.

You can repeat the above process if there is still some hair left, remember some hairs maybe too short to remove and you'll get them next time.

Should you accidentally get any product on an area not to be depilated, just remove with warm water, it will come off easily as it is water soluble.

Stubborn shorties

With this product you can remove hair as short as 2mm but again if they are too short (if you have been shaving or tweezing) you may need to wait a few days for more hair growth or try going over the area again. With shorter hairs you can apply the paste in the opposite direction to the hair growth to coat the underside of the hair fully.

Other Areas

Although we have made this sugar specifically for the top lip, it is versatile and can be used to remove hair from the chin and if necessary, from your hobbit toes! The same principle applies, just follow all the instructions for the top lip.
